

Tools & Supply List



This course provides how-tos and quick tutorials to create eight projects for gift-giving. Although themed for the winter holidays, the projects are suited for year-round use. Proper punching and binding with the Bind-it-All will be reviewed, as we see how quickly we can create homemade projects that everyone can enjoy!

Below lists the tools and supplies used in the class. Feel free to make your paper and embellishment selections based on your needs and desires. Optional tools are just that – optional. You can improvise with tools you have, or add them to your own wish list, if Zanta thinks you've been good. ☺ More tips on this will be provided in class.

Zutter Tools & Supplies Used:

- Bind-it-All (original blue or pink V2.0)
- ½” and ¾” owire – neutral color choices like Antique Brass or Antique Silver, or try **RED** for the holidays!
- Zutter Rivets - Antique Brass or Antique Silver/Black
- Variety of Zutter Chipboard, Corrugated Board, Zutter Cover-Alls, Clipboard Wood, Acrylic Covers, Canvas Artboard – you can also use scrap cardboard and chipboard you already have! *Many of these materials are clearance priced.*
- A suggested supply kit is available at www.binditall.com that includes clearance and discounted items.

Optional Zutter Tools Used:

- Zutter Hammer & Rivet Setter
- Dreamcuts
- Zutter Cutter
- Round-it-All (either the R5 or R10)
- Distrezz-it-All
- Pound-it-All



Basic Scrapbook supplies:

- Paper trimmer, wet and dry adhesive, ink for distressing and stamping, scoring tool, scissors, variety of border and shape punches, computer and printer for any class files you wish to print. Acrylic paint and misting sprays.
- Paper (double-side patterned recommended for most projects), cardstock and embellishments to suit your project theme and creative mojo.
- Paper quantities and suggestions will be provided in each project lesson.
